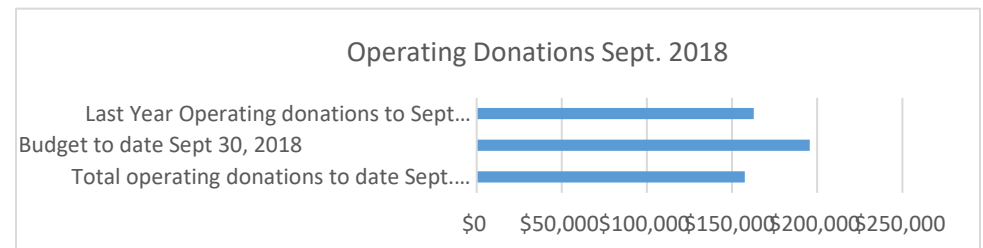
1. **This Sunday:** All young adults are invited to stay for lunch after the service. There's lots of good food and conversation to be shared!
