We realize, however, that the smudging outside our building on June 2 created significant difficulties for some of our community members. We wanted to honour the Indigenous practice of smudging and had assumed we could do that by moving the smudging outside, but significant scent carried into the church. We apologize for the discomfort this caused.

8. **Finance Update:** Total budget 2019 is \$275,000. Donations toward the budget received to the end of May: \$91,240 - that's 33% of our goal! Last year at the end of May we had reached 34%. During the summer the work of the church continues to impact our members and our neighbours. Let's keep up our support, even when we are present less often.
